

VEHICLE REGISTRATION

Fees and How to Register Vehicle:

Purchased vehicle from out of state owner or NC owner

- a. proper ID as required by G.S. 20-52(A) (see Official Bulletin 202)
- b. furnish title properly assigned
- c. complete form MVR-1 declaring all liens
- d. complete form MVR-615, Eligible Risk Statement for Insurance
- e. need odometer statement signed by all (seller and buyer)
- f. title fee of \$40.00, license fee and hut based on computer value
- g. title will be issued in owner's name and mailed to owner/lien holder
- h. Vehicle will require a NC inspection one year from issuance of NC Plate if purchased from out of state owner, if purchased from a NC owner vehicle must have a current inspection prior to registration

Vehicle purchased from dealer

- a. proper ID as required by G.S. 20-52(A) (see Official Bulletin 202)
- b. furnish title/MCO properly assigned
- c. complete form MVR-1 declaring all liens
- d. complete form MVR-615, Eligible Risk Statement for Insurance
- e. furnish odometer statement signed by seller/buyer
- f. hut based on purchase price of bill of sale less any trade in x 3%
- g. title will be issued in owner's name and mailed to owner/lien holder
- h. NC inspection is required prior to registration if purchased from a NC Dealer, if purchased from Out of State dealer customer can register vehicle first and will then have up to one year to obtain the NC inspection.

Coming in from another state vehicle registered owner's name

- a. proper ID as required by G.S. 20-52(A) (see Official Bulletin 202)
- b. furnish title in registered owner's name
- c. complete form MVR-1 declaring all liens
- d. Complete form MVR-615, Eligible Risk Statement for Insurance
- e. odometer reading if less than 10 years old
- f. title fee of \$40.00, license fee and hut max up to \$150.00
- g. No max at \$150 if adding an assignment. Must title as in previous state to qualify for cap at \$150. See 1-8-2 in title manual
- h. title will be issued in owner's name and mailed to owner/lien holder
- i. vehicle will require a NC inspection one year from issuance of NC Plate

Out of state title held by recorded lien holder

- a. proper ID as required by G.S. 20-52(A) (see Official Bulletin 202)
- b. out of state registration in owner's name
- c. complete form MVR-1 declaring all liens
- d. complete form MVR-615, Eligible Risk Statement for Insurance
- e. odometer reading if less than 10 years old
- f. title fee of \$40.00, license fee and hut up to \$150.00
- g. MVR-57 given to registered owner to send with next payment to lien holder. Upon receipt of title, Division will issue a NC title and mail to recorded lien holder.
- h. vehicle will require a NC inspection one year from issuance of NC Plate
