- \Box 1. New wireless support structures that are less than sixty (60) feet in height as measured from the ground.
- □ 2. Replacement poles located on public property or within utility easements or rights-of-way
- □ 3. Carrier on Wheels or Cell on Wheels (COWs)
- □ 4. Collocations
- □ 5. Removal or replacement of transmission equipment on an existing wireless tower or base station that does not result in a substantial modification as defined in the ordinance
- □ 6. Ordinary maintenance of existing wireless facilities and wireless support structures, as defined in the ordinance
- □ 7. Small Wireless Facilities including facilities placed on utility poles

Content of Application Package – New Sites, < 60' in height, COWs (#s 1 and 3 above):

- □ Tower Permit Application form signed by applicant
- □ Copy of lease or letter of authorization from property owner evidencing applicant's authority to pursue application. Such submissions need not disclose financial lease terms.
- □ Drawings which depict improvements related to the applicable requirements including:
 - □ Property Boundaries
 - □ Setbacks
 - □ Topography
 - \Box Elevation Sketch
 - □ Dimensions of Improvements
 - □ For COWs (#3 above), height shall not exceed 120' and must be located 150' from any structure and 150' from any property line.
- Documentation from a licensed professional engineer of calculation of the fall zone
- Certification from a licensed professional engineer that the wireless support structure has sufficient structural integrity to accommodate the required number of additional users as provided in the ordinance.

Content of Application Package – All other sites / facilities (#s 2, 4, 5, 6, and 7 above):

- □ Tower Permit Application form signed by applicant
- □ For **collocations (#4 above)**, written verification from a licensed professional engineer certifying that the host support structure is structurally and mechanically capable of supporting the proposed additional antenna or configuration of antennas, or a fall zone that measures at a minimum within the parcels lot lines, a circle whose center is the base of a telecommunications tower and whose radius is equal to one and one-half the tower's height documented by a NC licensed engineer and shall be marked by signage indicating the perimeters of the fall zone.
