

POLK COUNTY TRANSFER STATION GUIDELINES

Polk County residences have several options for the disposal of house whole waste

For those wishing to haul their own garbage
Polk County Solid Waste Transfer Station Options:

- ❖ \$ 7.00 - Per Trip Fee – Each trip to the PCSW Transfer Station
- ❖ \$75.00 - Yearly Permit Fee – No limit on trips to the PCSW Station

Our 'YEARLY PERMITS' and 'PER TRIP FEES' INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING STIPULATIONS:

1. Intended for the dumping of waste from one residence only
 2. May not be used for the dumping of quantities greater than 400lbs**
 - Construction waste
 - Yard wasteland
 - Clearing debris
 - Household garbage
 - Furniture
- **Loads in **excess** of 400lbs are weighed and charged by the ton for the entire load
3. May not be used for **ANY** commercial activity.
 4. It may **not** be used for waste resulting from **ANY** multi-family dwelling, such as a trailer park, rest home, apartment complex, communal living facility, or camp ground, etc.
 5. Yearly Permit Sticker – Purchaser must place sticker onto the front of a vehicle at the time of purchase or to a location *visible* to the scale attendant.
Another vehicle *may* be used for dumping, by a permit holder by presenting the receipt of purchase to the Scale Attendant.
 6. A permit may **not** be purchased by anyone not residing in Polk County.
 7. **CHARGES FOR THE FOLLOWING - EFFECTIVE AS OF - 'JULY 1, 2016'**
 - Computers and other household electronics - \$10.00 PER ITEM
 - Clean (unpainted) Block, brick, concrete, asphalt and uncontaminated dirt - \$20.00 PER TON

\$35.00 AVAILABILITY FEE

Included with each annual property tax bill is a \$35 solid waste availability fee.

This fee is assigned to each improved property.

The payment of this fee provides disposal, with no additional cost, of the following items to
POLK COUNTY RESIDENTS ONLY.

Recyclables:

- ❖ Food and Beverage Containers
- ❖ Mixed paper – Newspapers - Junk Mail - Books and Magazines
- ❖ Cardboard
- ❖ Waste Oil (household quantities)
- ❖ Scrap Tires
- ❖ Metal
- ❖ Appliances
- ❖ All Batteries - including automotive batteries
- ❖ Furniture - household quantities (less than 400lbs per load)
- ❖ Yard Waste (less than 400lbs per load)
- ❖ Paint (household quantities – maximum - 3 gallons per trip)
- ❖ Antifreeze (household quantities)
- ❖ Cell Phones, printer cartridges
- ❖ Fluorescent bulbs
