

NCSG Summary of Major Changes for 2024

New Activities

The following non-sanctioned events have the highest number of Local Games and participation and will be now be our newest sanctioned State Finals Activities in 2024:

- Cornhole doubles and mixed doubles
- Disc Golf

Removing Activities

The following activities have the lowest participation statewide and will be removed from State Finals in <u>2025:</u> Archery, Race Walks.

State Finals qualification criteria returns to pre-covid with the exception of open events. The Full qualification policy is as follows:

- The **top three male and female** qualifiers in each official North Carolina Senior Games sport/event in each age category will be eligible to participate in State Finals except:
- Bowlers: places 1-6
- Golfers must meet a minimum performance score (MPS) and finish 1, 2 or 3 to qualify.
- <u>All</u> participants who <u>complete</u> a Local Games **Fun Walk**, **Football Throw**, **Softball Throw and Basketball Shooting** will qualify.
- Teams: The first, second and third place teams per the team sport age category will qualify.
- In SilverArts, each Local Games may qualify:
- One entry in Performing Arts and the Cheerleader Showcase.
- First and second place in each Literary Arts sub-category, provided the places are not won by the <u>same</u> artist.
- First, second <u>and</u> third place entry in each <u>Visual Arts and Heritage Arts</u> sub-category, provided the places are not won by the <u>same</u> artist (i.e. only one entry by the same artist per sub-category).
- See the 2024 edition of the <u>NCSG Rules Book</u> for detailed sports changes. It will have its own "Summary of Changes" page in it. The <u>revised</u> edition will be presented at the Sports Management Clinic.
- See the 2024 edition of the <u>NCSG SilverArts Manual</u> for any changes. It will have its' own "Summary of Changes" page in it. The revised edition will be presented at the SilverArts Workshop.

REMINDERS:

- Remember qualifying date for age determination: A person must be 50 years of age or better as
 of <u>December 31st, 2024</u> to participate. A participant's age on <u>December 31st, 2024</u> determines the
 age category in which they will compete at the Local Game <u>and</u> State Finals.
- **Required:** Local Games **must** request an "E-Mail Address" from your participants on your Entry Forms *and enter it in Torch 1.0* This will allow for much more efficient communication with participants from you <u>and NCSG</u> (especially for State Finals!).
- Local Games should request their participants to have a photo ID available for check-in each
 day at each activity to encourage this good habit for State Finals and for their personal safety.
